

Meeting Rooms


Be sure to request a room in the Palace Tower. The elevators to the Palace Tower rooms are right in front of the meeting center.






NETWORKING EVENT



ONE-ON-ONE SESSION

Each company attending MCON will be given a 30 minute time slot to meet one-on-one with a member of the Mirus team.

During your one-on-one session you can discuss:

- Current projects
- New Feature Ideas
- Future Projects
- Report Writing Questions
- Anything you'd like

Some examples to get you thinking:

Is there a report you are working on that you can't figure out?

Is there a task that you are doing daily or weekly that we can help you automate? It can be as simple as: you log into Mirus and look at 3 reports everyday. We could make the reports Favorites, or put them on a dashboard, or even schedule them as a group alert.
